### THE LCRT BOARD

**ANITA SWANSON (President)**, was active in LA Theatre for several years before moving to Washington DC and then onto Lake County. Her resume includes Regional as well as National commercials. She trained at the Lee Strasberg for three years before moving onto theatre productions in the LA area. She has appeared in Student Film projects for UCLA as well as the television show "FUDGE" and "Dame EDNA." She is member of SAG.

**RICH ALTMAN (Vice President)** has been living in Lake County for over 20 years. He designed the LCRT website [lcrt.org](http://lcrt.org) and is a musician (church organist and choir master) and computer expert. He performed as an entertainer while living in the Bay Area, and has worked with the Lower Lake Museum in their *Somewhere in Time* fundraisers. He and his wife, Linda, are ardent supporters of LCRT and have a menagerie of animals to fill their spare time.

**VORIS BRUMFIELD (Secretary)** loves to direct, take photos, email, and design newsletters. She is also a 28 year resident of Lake County with a theatre degree from the University of Denver. Numerous plays in Lake County for Yuba College and for LCRT have been

directed by Voris. She was the executive Director for a professional theatre company in Houston for 3 years with a \$300,000 budget, a former County Supervisor and currently, workshop facilitation for persons entering the job market is her full time job.
