Playwriting Festival '04 Update

Linda Altman confirmed that, as of 9/15/03, we have had over 140 inquiries and have received 26 play submissions for the Festival. After the October 1 deadline passes, Board members (and others) will be asked to read two or three plays and "critique" them. A form has been created for the critique. A "read-off" of the top four plays will be held in January 2004. 1st Prize cash award (for the winning playwright) is \$300.00 or %10 of the gross house, whichever is greater.

Treasurer's Report Treasurer's Report was made by Jane Weaver. As of 9/10/03, LCRT has \$6,650.73 in our account. Jane also presented other bills which need to be paid: LCAC (Lake County Arts Council) ~ \$100 membership and \$325 for insurance (total \$425) and LCCAG (Lake County Community Action Group) ~ \$350 for storage and use of building for rehearsals.
